

Advanced Cardiac Life Support - Renewal

This course is designed individuals who have previously completed an ACLS course and have a current ACLS card. Participants will refresh their knowledge and skills to remain current. Special emphasis is placed on a review of the roles an individual may have in the management of a cardiopulmonary arrest and special pre-arrest situations. The course consists of eight hours of review, practice and evaluation situations. (8 hours CME credit)

Upon completion of this educational activity, participants will be able to:

- Identify the current educational goals of the AHA ACLS course.
- Identify components of successful management of the first ten minutes of VF arrest.
- Discuss the primary and secondary approach to emergency cardiac care.
- Demonstrate appropriate use of adjuncts for airway control, ventilation and oxygenation.
- Recognize and identify appropriate treatment for most frequent cardiac arrest rhythms.
- Demonstrate correct procedure for use of automatic external defibrillator.
- Identify correct procedure for cardioversion.
- Demonstrate knowledge of “why, when, how to use, and precautions” for selected pharmacological agents used in ACLS.
- Demonstrate use of external cardiac pacing.
- Act as team leader of a resuscitation team in mock situation, demonstrating core knowledge and skill.

Note: As an alternative, physicians may take an online “American Heart Association” course at their leisure and then schedule check-offs at MIMC through the Education Department; call 435-5089. Card cost is \$5.00.
