

Pediatric Advance Life Support Provider Course

This course is designed for health care professionals whose occupation requires proficiency in the knowledge and skills of pediatric resuscitation. Special emphasis is placed on a review of the roles an individual may have in the management of a cardiopulmonary arrest and special pre-arrest situations. The course consists of two, eight hour classes. To register for the course, a copy of a current BLS card must accompany a print-out of an 80% or greater score on the PALS pre-test. Textbooks required for the class are the PALS Course Guide and the PALS Provider Manual dated 2006 by the American Heart Association. Within the PALS Course Guide is the CD-ROM with the pre-test to complete and print out. (16 Hours CME credit)

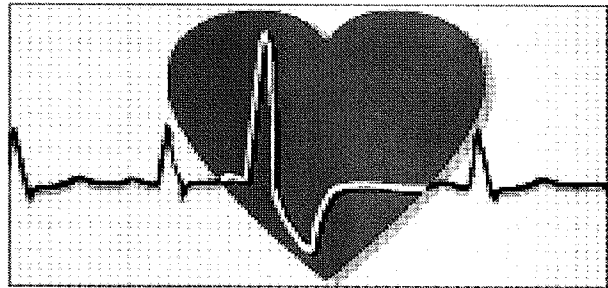
Participants must have a current “American Heart Association” BLS card and a pre-test completion with 80% or greater score. Card & pre-test score must be provided to register.
