

Pediatric Advance Life Support Renewal Course

This course is designed for health care professionals whose occupation requires proficiency in the knowledge and skills of pediatric resuscitation. Special emphasis is placed on a review of the roles an individual may have in the management of a cardiopulmonary arrest and special pre-arrest situations. The course consists of one, eight hour class. (8 Hours CME credit)

Pre-Requisites

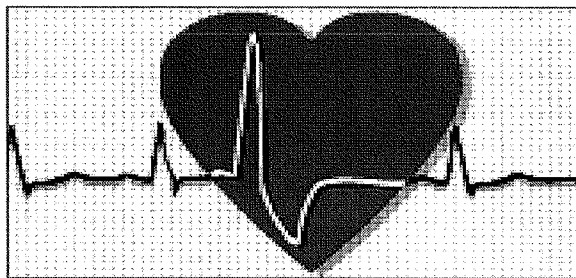
